WHAT DOES ALASKA USA MORTGAGE COMPANY DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and credit history
- Credit scores and credit card or other debt
- Transaction history and payment history

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Alaska USA Mortgage Company chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do		
How does Alaska USA Mortgage Company protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does Alaska USA Mortgage Company collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Apply for a loan or give us your contact information. Provide account or income information. Give us your employment history. We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness. Affiliates from using your information to market to you. Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. (See below for more on your rights under state law.) 	
 Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Affiliated companies include Alaska USA Federal Credit Union, Alaska USA Insurance Brokers, and Alaska USA Trust Company.	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliated companies include credit bureaus, appraisal management companies, and identity, income, and tax verification services.	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Alaska USA Mortgage Company does not share.	

Other important information

Alaska USA Mortgage Company does not share information about your transactions and experiences for our affiliates' everyday business purposes in the state of California.
